To receive such goodwill payment, investors have to contact the Issuer no later than 18:00h local time Zurich on the Business Day following the Expiry. Thereafter, no goodwill payment will be made.

The goodwill payment amount will be determined by the Calculation Agent and is defined as:

Min(Underlying price at 12:00h local time Zurich on Expiration Date, Settlement Price) – Strike, adjusted for the Conversion Ratio and converted into the Redemption Currency, if applicable.

For the avoidance of doubt, if either the Underlying price at 12:00h local time Zurich on the Expiration Date or the Settlement Price are equal or below the Strike, no payment will be made.

Tax Treatment Switzerland
